Jubilee Logo: Meaning

The four figures represent humanity as a whole, in its differences and similarities. They proceed to embrace each other, expressing the solidarity and brotherhood that should unite the peoples of the world. Leading them is the red figure, clinging to a Cross formed by a black curve that ends, at the bottom, with an anchor. The Cross is not rigid, not static, but bends towards humanity as if to embrace it. As for the anchor, Monsignor Fisichella himself explained its meaning: "As is known, the anchor has often been used as a metaphor for hope. The anchor of hope is the name given in seafaring jargon to the reserve anchor, used by vessels to perform emergency maneuvers to stabilize the ship during storms." The sense of this symbol in the Jubilee logo is clear: it is precisely in the most difficult moments that we need to rely on an anchor that gives us security and guarantees salvation, and what better anchor than the Cross, a symbol of Christ and His infinite love for all of us? The presence of small agitated waves at the bottom of the logo confirms the existence of dangers and obstacles, of those personal events and events of the world that make each of our lives not always easy.

Thus, the logo in its entirety takes on a clear meaning, and the Jubilee, with its twelve months of ceremonies and initiatives, becomes a long pilgrimage to be undertaken together, as brothers, towards salvation, guided by the Cross and the hope of salvation promised by God.

Logo Jubileo: Significado

Las cuatro figuras representan a la humanidad en su conjunto, en sus diferencias y semejanzas. Se abrazan entre sí, expresando la solidaridad y la hermandad que debe unir a los pueblos del mundo. Al frente de ellos está la figura roja, aferrada a una Cruz formada por una curva negra que termina, en la parte inferior, con un ancla. La Cruz no es rígida, no es estática, sino que se inclina hacia la humanidad como para abrazarla. En cuanto al ancla, el mismo Monseñor Fisichella explicó su significado: "Como es sabido, el ancla se ha utilizado a menudo como metáfora de la esperanza. El ancla de la esperanza es el nombre que se da en la jerga marinera al ancla de reserva, utilizada por las embarcaciones para realizar maniobras de emergencia para estabilizar el barco durante las tormentas". El sentido de este símbolo en el logo del Jubileo es claro: es precisamente en los momentos más difíciles cuando necesitamos apoyarnos en un ancla que nos dé seguridad y nos garantice la salvación, y ¿qué mejor ancla que la Cruz, símbolo de Cristo y de su infinito amor por todos nosotros? La presencia de pequeñas olas agitadas en la parte inferior del logo confirma la existencia de peligros y obstáculos, de esos acontecimientos personales y del mundo que hacen que la vida de cada uno no sea siempre fácil. Así, el logotipo en su conjunto adquiere un significado claro y el Jubileo, con sus doce meses de ceremonias e iniciativas, se convierte en una larga peregrinación que recorreremos juntos, como hermanos, hacia la salvación, guiados por la Cruz y la esperanza de la salvación prometida por Dios.
